

Pray for Vocations

The word vocation is simply the Latinate term for "calling." The best biblical formulation of the concept of vocations is from 1 Corinthians 7:17: "Let each person lead the life that the Lord has assigned to him, and to which God has called him." Thus, God assigns different vocations for each person and then calls each one by name.
