



This Son Of Mine Was Dead, And Has Come To Life Again!

Dear Parish Family,

This week, in place of my usual chatty bulletin letter, I decided to explain a very important item that is found in every Catholic Church. That Item is the Sanctuary Lamp, also known as the Sanctuary Candle.

The <u>Sanctuary Candle</u> is the candle near the Tabernacle in all Catholic Churches. Usually it is displayed in a candle holder with a red globe or candle shade. It may, however be clear or any other color of glass. The <u>Tabernacle</u> is where the Consecrated Hosts which have not been used during Mass, are kept. The Sanctuary Candle or Lamp reminds us that <u>Jesus is present in the Consecrated Hosts</u> reserved in the Tabernacle. He is truly present at Mass and in the Tabernacle. The candle should always be lit unless there are no Communion Hosts in the Tabernacle.

At the end of the Mass on Holy Thursday, the Altar is stripped (everything is removed) and the Sanctuary Candle is extinguished. A temporary candle is placed near the Altar of Repose. Here at Our Lady of Lourdes, our Altar of Repose is usually in the hall, surrounded by flowers. We often refer to that as "the garden". The Sanctuary Lamp is not relit until the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday.

These practices and traditions are so beautiful. They keep us ever mindful of the presence of Jesus, not just in the Church, but in our daily lives. How easy it is to forget that Jesus comes to stay with us, as the Bible says, He abides with us. Even during the rigors of Lent, we have the consolation and joy of our Lord — in our Tabernacle, in our Church, in our hearts.

The Sanctuary candle will burn this year in loving memory of a deceased member of the parish. This donation is made by her family, who wishes to remain anonymous .

Sticking with the theme of candles and light: "The Light Is On For You" will be held every Monday evening, from 6:10 to 6:50 p.m. During this time, Fr. Mike will be available for Confessions, and the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed for Adoration. Come home to the Church and spend some time in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament.
