

"Who is this Whom even wind and sea obey?" (Mark 4:41)

Dear Parish Family,

I am writing this to all of you from the comfort of my air conditioned office on the hottest day of the year so far. As most of you know, I really do not like hot weather. In fact, I jokingly say that the

only reason I try to be good is because hell is hot. Actually, Jesus always reminds me of this on these hot days: to pray for those who are suffering, to rejoice with/for those who are enjoying the summer, and to stop complaining (it is not a "good look" for a priest).

This weekend our Gospel reading reveals the power of Jesus in one of His so-called nature miracles. He calms the storms and quells the fears of the disciples in the boat being buffeted by wind and wave. Jesus, Himself, had been sleeping through the tumult. The obvious message is that when we are weathering the storms of life from illness to difficult relationships and loss, Jesus is always there to comfort us.

If He appears to be sleeping in our difficult times, it is because our faith in Him has fallen asleep. What do I mean? I mean you have forgotten, in some way, His presence. Perhaps you have relied too much upon yourself without seeking Him. Rouse Him, then; Remember Him! Let Him keep watch within you. Pay heed to Him. Saint Augustine once wrote, "Try, then, to be more like the wind and the sea; obey the God who made you. The sea obeys Christ's command, and are you going to turn a deaf ear to it? The sea obeys Him, the wind is still; will you persist with your blustering?"

Blustering or sweltering, trust in Jesus.
