

Dear Parish Family,

First of all, I must begin with a bit of irritating business. I have been hacked AGAIN! People are receiving emails and texts, supposedly from me, asking them to send me money for all kinds of seemingly good things. PLEASE DO NOT SEND MONEY IN RESPONSE TO THOSE TEXTS AND EMAILS! Also do not ever

respond to them because then they have your information. If I needed some kind of assistance I would always approach you directly either by phone (where you could recognize my voice and my goofy laugh) or face to face. I apologize for the concern or confusion this has caused some of you.

Now get ready for one of my really bad transitions. Our readings this week all refer to shepherds and sheep. The sheep know the shepherd's voice. See what I did there?

How are we to know the voice of God? When is it Him? When is it someone trying to imitate Him? When is it the evil one? When are we confusing our desires with His will? To help us discern His voice from all the noise of the world, I borrowed a few statements from other writers.

 $\cdot$  The voice of God is recognized in whispers of the heart & in soft tones, even as it is recognized in thunder and in the midst of the storms of life.

 $\cdot$  The voice of God is recognized wherever one finds life, joy, health, beauty, and humor, even as it is recognized wherever one sees and responds to the dying, suffering, poor, and the beaten-down.

 $\cdot$  The voice of God is the one that most challenges and stretches us, even as it the only voice that ultimately soothes and comforts us.

• The voice of God enters our lives as the greatest of all powers, even as it forever lies in vulnerability, like a helpless baby in the straw.

 $\cdot$  The voice of God always invites us to live beyond all fear, even as it inspires Holy fear.

 $\cdot$  The voice of God is always heard wherever there is genuine enjoyment and gratitude, even as it asks us to deny ourselves and die to ourselves.
