Dear Parish Family and Friends,

The Holy Solemnity we celebrate this weekend puts new heart into us, for not only do we revere It's dignity, we also experience the delight of the Holy Spirit. Some of you may remember when Fr. Manno referred to Pentecost as the "feast of love." Saint Aelred poetically states, "There is no word pleasanter to the ear, no thought more tenderly dwelt on, than love."

This weekend we experience the joy of love for those who are receiving the Holy Spirit and the gifts He gives as we celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation. Thirteen of our teens and one adult will be confirmed in the faith. The power of the Holy Spirit now leaps forward into the hearts of those who have offered themselves for this Sacrament. Our students memorized this definition: "Confirmation is a Sacrament in which the Holy Spirit comes to us in a special way to make us strong and perfect Christians and witnesses of Jesus Christ." Though few of us are perfect, every encounter with the Holy Spirit makes us more perfect Christians.

I am so blessed to be able to confer this sacrament this year. The ordinary minister of Confirmation is the Bishop, however, he has extended to me, as your Pastor the faculty to act in his stead once again this year, as he has for other pastors in their parishes.

Since the very first Pentecost, the voice of the Lord has resounded. The majesty of God has thundered. If you listen with ears of faith and watch with faithful eyes, you will hear Him thunder and see His glory resound in our Mass today and in those who are being Confirmed.


